Energy Transition & Clean Renewable Energy

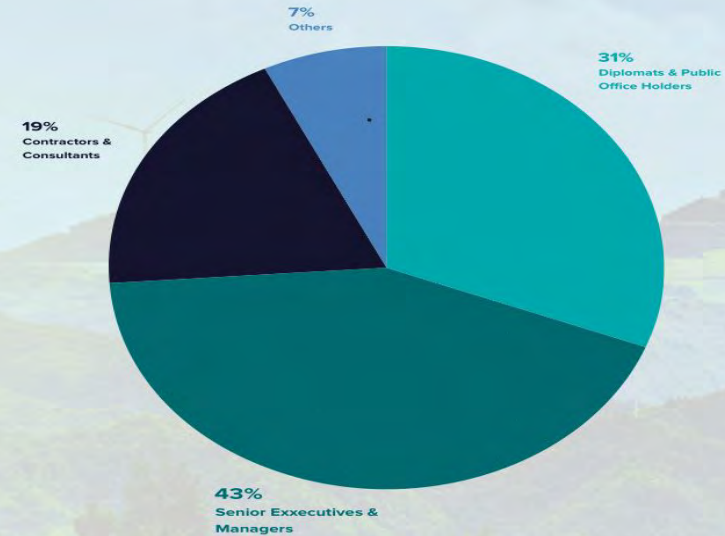
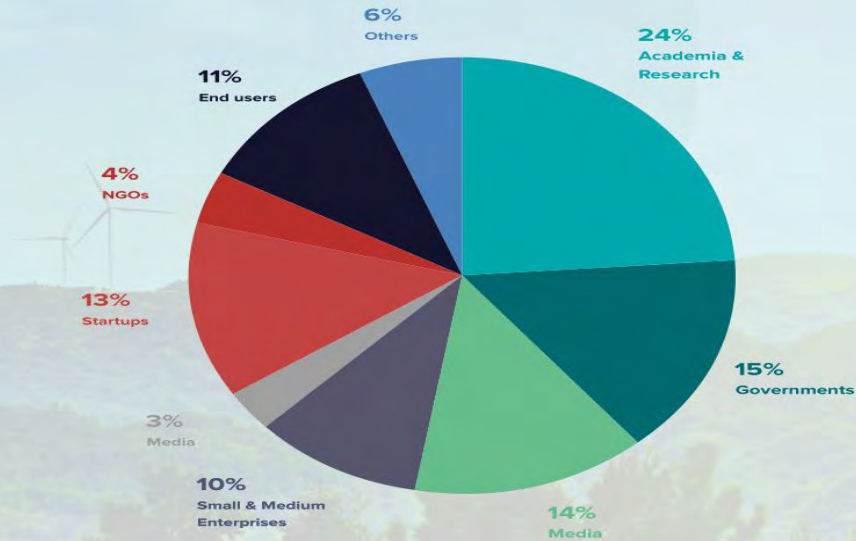

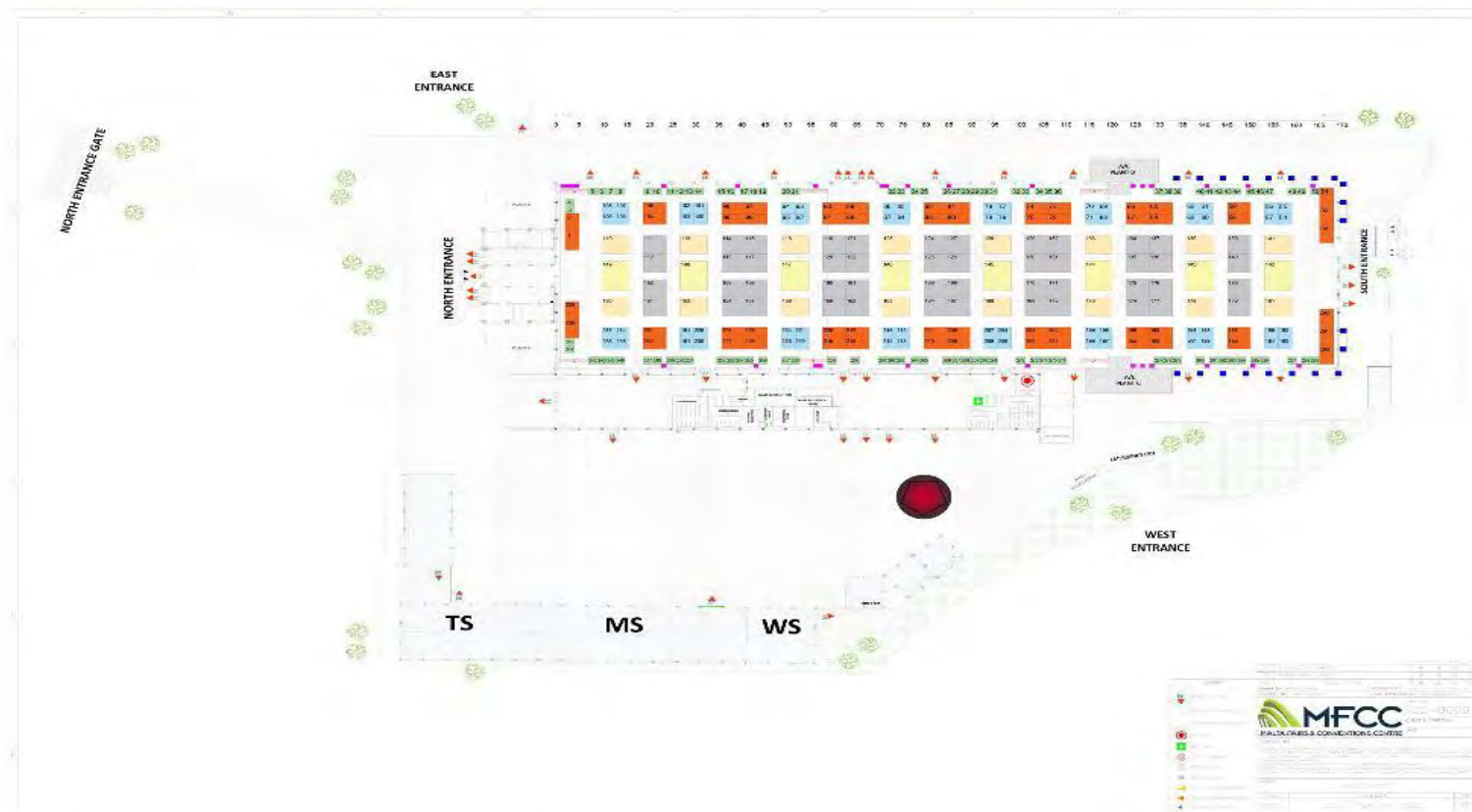
